MANHATTAN COUNTRY CLUB PRESCHOOL REQUIREMENTS FOR THE FIRST DAY FULL DAY AND HALF DAY

In order to ensure the best experience for your child, the following items are required and must be brought on the first day of Preschool:

- All required paperwork
- FULL DAY ONLY: bring a sleeping mat, and extra sheets
- An Emergency Pack for each child (see below)
- One package of diapers and one package wipes (if required)
- Change of clothes (will stay at school)
- Swim suit for water play

Please make sure to bring all items listed so that your child's first day at Manhattan Country Club Preschool can go as smoothly as possible. Thank you!

EMERGENCY PACK

The safety and well-being of your child is our primary concern at Manhattan Country Club Preschool. Therefore, all students are required to bring an Emergency Pack to class on the first day. The following items must be contained in a gallon size Ziploc bag:

A photograph of your child
A 3" x 5" card with your child's name and emergency information (parents'/guardians' names and contact phone numbers, emergency contact person's info, etc.)
One emergency blanket (found in the camping section at Target)
Three non-perishable food items (no cans that require an opener!)

It is important to be prepared in any situation that we could encounter this school year. This Emergency Pack will ensure that your child has the proper essentials should an emergency situation arise.
